#### THE ABC'S OF SALVATION

- A Admit to God that you are a sinner. "For all have sinned and fall short of the Glory of God" (Romans 3:23). The result of sin is spiritual death (Romans 6:23). Admitting that you are a sinner and separated from God is the first step of repentance, which is turning from sin and self and turning toward God.
- **B** Believe in Jesus Christ as God's Son and receive Jesus' gift of forgiveness from sin. God offers His love and salvation to each of us through the death of His Son on the cross. "For God so loved the world that He gave His One and Only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
- C Confess Jesus as your Lord. "If you confess with your mouth, Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. With the heart one believes resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth one confesses, resulting in salvation" (Romans 10:9-10). Believe in Jesus as Lord and confess that to Him and share your decision with others. We invite you to share your decision with us at Eastside or with a pastor you know. Then follow Christ's example by being baptized by immersion in a local church as an expression of your faith.
